This form was designed as a planning worksheet to assist in coordinating your plans for the men's attire for your wedding. Fill in the form and bring it with you to your Nedrebo's Authorized Dealer to streamline your planning process.

STEP 1: GETTING STARTED

Print this form and complete your personal information.

STEP 2: SELECTING YOUR WEDDING DAY ATTIRE

In most weddings, all the men wear the same style coat, pants, shirt, and shoes. The groom is often differentiated from his attendants by the color of his vest and/or tie and pocket square. Some couples may prefer that the groom wear a different color or style of coat in order to stand apart from his men. The above suggestions do NOT apply to weddings of ultra-formal, traditional etiquette, where gentlemen wear the Cutaway, Stroller or traditional "White Tie & Tails." In these cases, all men are attired exactly the same.

When deciding who to include in your wedding party plans, be sure to consider all of the family members who will be appearing in your wedding pictures.

STEP 3: VISIT A STORE

STEP 4: GETTING THE GUYS MEASURED

Ask the gentlemen in your wedding to get measured at any formalwear or menswear specialist in their area. This service is frequently provided at no charge. They should print the measurement form, available on our website, and bring it with them. They can then fax or call their measurements into your Nedrebo's Authorized Dealer retailer at least one month before your wedding, so that the orders can be prepared for delivery.

Groom			
The groom often wears a white or ivory vest to complement the bride's gown and stand apart from the men in his wedding party. His accessories are often lighter in color than the rest of the party.			
Best Man			
The best man typically wears the same ensemble as the other groomsmen.			
Groomsmen			
The groomsmen typically wear accessories that complement the color of the bridesmaids' dresses. Sometimes they wear a neutral color.			
Jr. Groomsmen			
Typically dressed identical to the rest of the groomsmen.			
Ushers			
It is recommended to have one usher for every 50-75 guests. Ushers typically wear the same styles as the groomsmen, but are often distinguished by black accessories.			
Ring Bearer			
The ring bearer style choice is dictated by the flower girl. If she is dressed in white or ivory the bring bearer would dress identical to the groom. If she matches the bridesmaids, he will match the groomsmen. The youngest recommended age for a ring bearer is three years.			
Fathers			
Traditionally, both bothers are dressed the same, wearing black accessories. However, they can also wear accessories that complement the mothers' gowns.			
Stepfathers			
Stepfathers usually wear the same garment as the fathers.			
Grandfathers			
Grandfathers usually wear the same garment as the fathers. They should receive special consideration as their age lends them to more traditional choices.
